
A Practical Solution



This barn design is shown with rustic looking overhead doors, and you can add your own cupola for that finishing touch. The Adams is a 25' x 37' barn/garage with a 12-foot lean-to shed for snowmobiles, bikes, and ATVs. Or, left open, the shed can become a drive-through tractor bay.

Upstairs, the residence provides ample space to use for guests, a weekend retreat, or a short-term stay while building a larger home. Two bedrooms, a great room, 3/4 bath, and an eat-in kitchen provide all you'll need to stay where you play or plan for the future under the timber beams of this timeless, practical barn home!


Barns are where timber frame architecture first made its mark. Whether you need to divide your barn into many stalls for livestock or leave it open to store heavy equipment, a timber frame barn



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
can deliver; with no need for load-bearing walls, you can be flexible.


MAIN FLOOR 1369 SF
